Sample Form for Resolutions

The Whereas Clause(s): Give reasons for seeking a position or action by listing existing policy, concerns, facts, potential effects upon physicians, patients, practice or medicine, etc. Each fact/thought should be within a separate “whereas.”

The Resolved Clause(s): State the position(s) or action(s) you wish TMA to take on the issue. The Resolved Clause is the **only portion on which the House of Delegates will act**. Each Resolved Clause should stand alone and not contain external references.
